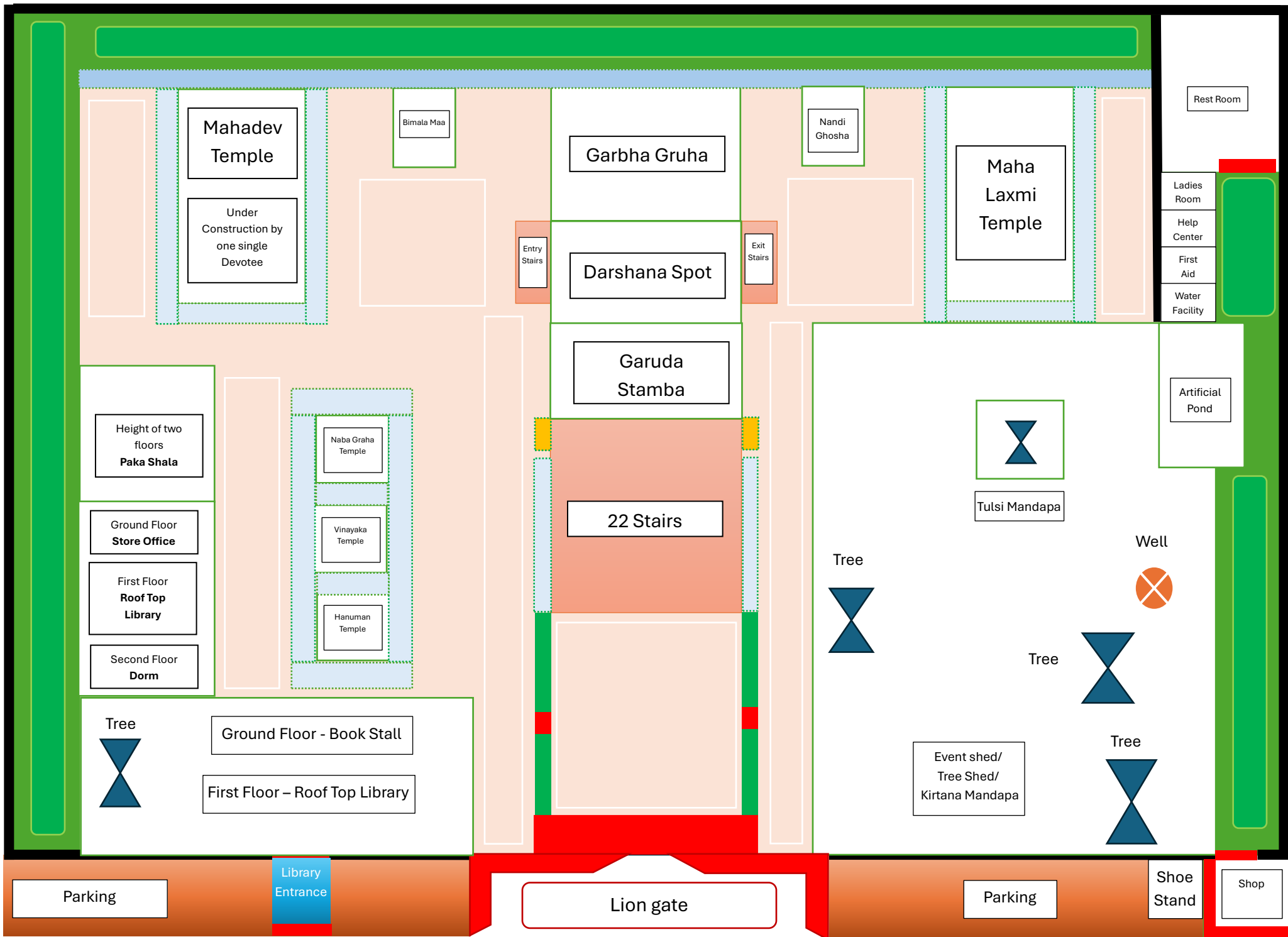

# Project - 1



## Finishing of the Temple



The **Garbha Gruha** – गर्भगृह also known as the "**Sanctum Sanctorum**," is the innermost and most sacred chamber of a Hindu temple.

The **Dadhinauti**, along with the **Neelachakra** (the blue wheel atop the temple), is a prominent feature.

**Dadhinauti** refers to a golden finial or crown-like structure situated at the top of the temple's main **shikhara** (tower)

### Garuda Stamba



A **Garuda Stambha** is a pillar found in front of Vishnu temples, featuring an image of **Garuda**, the bird vehicle of Lord Vishnu. It symbolizes Garuda's devotion and serves as a protective marker at the temple entrance.

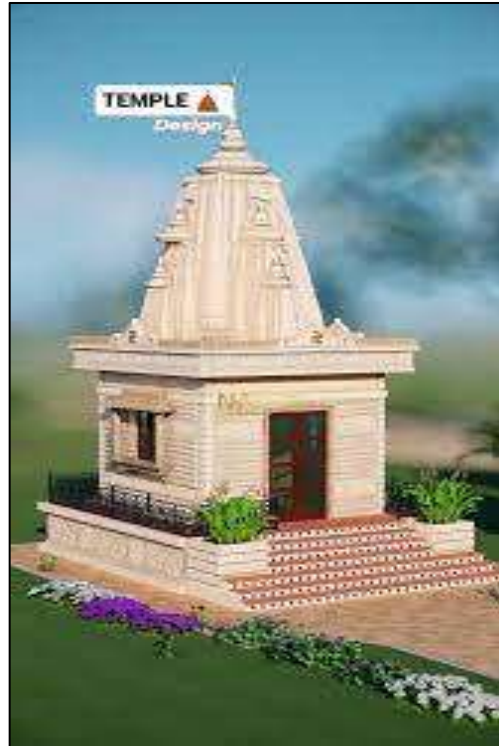

## Renovation of Paka Shala

### Present



### Future

A room for preparing Lord Jagannath's prasadam should have been equipped with a clean cooking area, traditional clay ovens (chulhas) or modern stoves, ample water supply, and storage for ingredients. It should have included utensils, proper ventilation, fire safety equipment, and hygiene supplies like handwashing stations. Additionally, waste disposal and storage for cooked prasadam should have been provided, along with a first aid kit and a rest area for cooks.

Prasadam of Lord Jagannath is considered a divine blessing, sanctified by the deity and believed to purify the soul. It symbolizes unity, as it is shared equally among all devotees, transcending social distinctions.

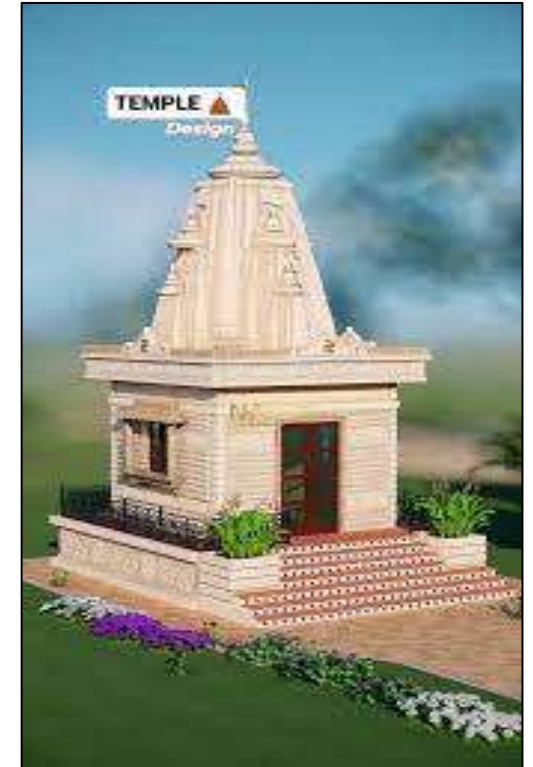
## Renovation of Bimala Maa Temple
